Interim report of the eLiLL Project E-LiLL questionnaire report

Research report :

The aim of this report is to provide empiric data which spotlight or clarify in various ways the educational possibilities for adult people in the Czech Republic, specifically of pre-senior and senior ages in dimensions presented in e-LiLL objectives (in the area of education with support of functional literacy and development of interests in the frame of quality of spending leisure time).

Research methodology

From the Internet research of public educational offer for adult people we obtained a general overview on what educational activities are offered (advertised) by various institutions and organizations. The procedure, we chose, is close to what is probably done by a man who is searching for an educational activity to satisfy his/her need for education. The survey lasted in period from April to June 2006 and has two phases.

In the first phase we looked for information on possibilities of education allocated for adult people on the Internet pages of special institutions. We concentrated on provider's name, name of educational activity, subject, and the web page of educational action. We parallelly started in searching for information via the Internet portals (Seznam : www.seznam.cz, Atlas: www.atlas.cz a Google : www.google.com).

The way out for our searching was distributing of providers of education for adult people into groups and so defining further way of searching information on websites. We started to work with three groups of educators. Internally we denoted them as: *schools* (basic, secondary, higher secondary schools, and especially universities), *libraries* and *nongovernmental nonprofit organizations*. We addressed their statutory representatives and asked contact persons for cooperation. In period from 23rd November to 4th December 2006 we repeatedly electronically contacted these institutions as they clearly advertised at least one type of activity for adult people and seniors in their offer:

In the second phase of investigation we began to analyze the obtained data in detail. In view of specific delimitation of surveyed set (adult people at later age), and marked predominance of university offer, the outline and profile of offer, would neither be clear nor sufficient. The strongest categories (universities) would cover up profiles of other providers with their parameters. Moreover, the data from education providers obtained from questionnaires of the remaining sets were even not sufficiently valid.

Research set

Therefore, our work stemmed from the only (homogeneous) set of education providers of adult people at later age, respectively, seniors, which means worked with university institutions. All of active members from the whole number of 32 asked colleges and faculties associated in the Association of the Universities of the Third Age (A U3A) in the Czech Republic were involved in e-LiLL project activities.

Impressive representation of universities in European e-LiLL project gives the possibility to profoundly analyze educational offer for adult people and seniors in programmes of universities of the third age (U3A), and to interpret it in broader European context.

Research methodology

The strategy of quantitative survey, method of content analysis of research offer of education providers (groups of universities with U3A), inquiry technique (E-LiLL Questionnaire), evaluation tools, testing of good project examples, good practice example, were chosen to accomplishment of research targets.

Decision, on what extent the results of questionnaire survey will be processed, will be made after evaluation of the first phase of project – after analysis of already presented e-LiLL questionnaire, and

before the actual preparation of good practice examples analysis. In case of an agreement on elaborating a comparative study, recording sheets (excel tables) to processing relevant data will be prepared, and their secondary analysis will be made.

Major findings

The offer of educational possibilities (educational activities) for adult people and seniors in the Czech Republic is really varied, however, it is often very fragmented, and that is why it is comprehended with difficulty. The strongest categories of education providers allocated to adult people at later age and seniors are the universities. Their parameters cover up the offers of further providers. In the subsequent partial report we present a description of data worked-out from questions provided by universities through e-LiLL questionnaire:
